The Schenectady Museum & Suits-Bueche Planetarium is a dynamic destination celebrating science, invention, and imagination. In addition to exploring the area's cultural and technological heritage, the Museum also offers some of the region's finest changing exhibits. The Museum is a must-see for tour groups, visitors, and area residents.

With new shows, NASA footage, and an astronomy expert, the Museum's Suits-Bueche Planetarium is the coolest planetarium in the galaxy! The Planetarium offers a changing schedule of exciting shows. Special customized shows are available for groups.

The Museum's International Technology Archives & Imaging Library receives visitors and queries from around the world. The Archives include the 1.5 million-image General Electric Photograph Collection, the seventh largest photograph collection in the United States outside the federal government.

The Museum Shop, one of the region's premiere gift shops, offers high-quality and unusual items such as hand-crafted clothing and jewelry and entertaining and educational toys.

### DIRECTIONS

*Directions From Thruway:* NYS Thruway to Exit 25. Follow I-890 west to Exit 5 - Broadway and bear to the right. Go to the first traffic light on Broadway and take a right on to Millard Street. Continue on Millard Street through 3 intersections, which takes you across Albany Street and State Street. After you cross State Street, Millard Street will become Nott Terrace. Take the second right on Nott Terrace to Nott Terrace Heights. Go to the top of the hill. The museum is on your right.

*Directions From Northway:* Take the Northway to Exit 6 and take Route 7 west towards Schenectady. Follow Route 7 about 6 miles to Union Street. Take Union Street to Nott Terrace and turn left. Turn left on Nott Terrace Heights. Go to the top of the hill. The museum is on your right.
